


Pass Down Plants

February's featured speaker Master Gardener Teena Spindler will discuss how to share treasured plants from your garden in her February 24th Zoom presentation "Pass Down Plants". Garden Club members will learn the types of plants easiest to share and useful propagation techniques, including safety tips to follow in order not to pass down disease or pests when sharing your garden plants.

Teena is a lifelong avid home gardening enthusiast, is the current President of the Great Park Garden Coalition dedicated to preserving Irvine's 59-acre botanical garden, co-hosts the weekly radio show "In the Garden" on KUCI FM with other University of California Master Gardeners, and was the Western US spokesperson 'Gardeniere' for Scotts Miracle Gro and Home Depot from 2012-2016.

Teena led the Master Gardener volunteers who created the Farm + Food Lab garden, is a docent at the Centennial Farm at the Orange County fairgrounds, has appeared in a number of 'how to' videos posted on YouTube on a wide variety of gardening topics, and volunteers at various other Master Gardener venues.

As a Master Composter, Teena regularly delivers talks on composting, edibles, and California native plants to gardening clubs and conferences throughout the state. Teena lives in Irvine with her husband, and has two grown children who come back often to enjoy the harvest from her garden.

"Friends are the flowers in the garden of life." Teena believes gardeners plants 'friends' in their garden whenever flowers and plants from friends are shared. Passing down plants will result in a garden that is not just beautiful, but is a wonderful reminder from nature to nurture our friendships.
