We are currently looking for donations of the following:

- Food, both wet and dry
- Litter, preferably scoopable
- Donations - to help cover the cost of adoption, supplies and veterinary care when needed.

Our foster program focuses on well-mannered, friendly and mature cats that come to us by way of owners going into long-term care or for other reasons unable to care for their beloved kitty. We also occasionally take from animal shelters such as the OC animal shelter located in the city of Orange as a courtesy posting.

All of the cats coming into the program are evaluated to ensure they are sociable and friendly and suitable to be adopted. They are given all needed vaccines, tested for various diseases, given a flea treatment and a clean bill of health.

Because these cats are mature, they are house-broken and just looking for a warm lap and a big heart to spend time with. Whether wanting to foster or adopt, there is very little that can give you the joy of a furry friend to share your life with.
